# **Economic Development**

Importance: 62%

Focus: Fully Funded Law Enforcement, Low Regulations,

Smart Growth, Limited Government

- Support tax incentives and other growth-oriented policies that attract the right kinds of businesses to the region.
- Emphasize limited government intervention, ensuring a pro-business environment that fosters smart, sustainable growth.



# **Education Funding**

Importance: 58%

Focus: Fully Funded Public Education

### **Healthcare**

Importance: 53%

Focus: Reducing Regulations, Addressing Big Pharma, Expanding Free Enterprise

Healthcare remains a challenge for many businesses, especially around the rising costs of insurance and regulatory burdens. We support reforms that reduce regulations on healthcare providers and businesses, while addressing the influence of large pharmaceutical companies. Encouraging competition and free-market solutions will help drive down healthcare costs for employers and employees.

- Reduce healthcare-related regulatory burdens on small businesses.
- Advocate for transparency and accountability in pharmaceutical pricing.
- Support policies that promote competition in healthcare services to lower costs and increase access.
